Admission Policy

Admission Criteria:

<u>Academic Preparedness:</u> Prospective students should demonstrate a strong academic foundation, as evidenced by previous academic records, assessments, and potential for success within the IB curriculum.

<u>Character and Values:</u> We seek students who embody the IB learner profile, displaying attributes such as inquisitiveness, open-mindedness, resilience, compassion, and a commitment to global citizenship.

<u>Diversity and Inclusion:</u> Smart Innovations School values diversity in its student body and actively seeks to enroll students from varied cultural, socio-economic, and academic backgrounds.

Admission Process:

<u>Application Submission:</u> Families interested in enrolling their child must complete the official application form, providing academic transcripts, recommendation letters, and any additional information that highlights the student's achievements and character.

<u>Assessment and Evaluation:</u> Applicants may be invited for assessments or interviews to evaluate their academic readiness, cognitive skills, personal attributes, and alignment with the school's values and philosophy.

<u>Waitlist:</u> In cases where available spaces are limited, qualified applicants may be placed on a waitlist. Offers will be extended based on the waitlist order as vacancies arise.
