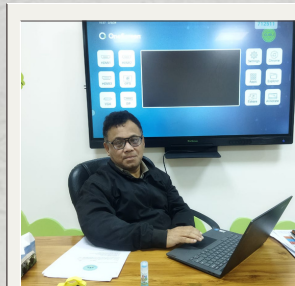

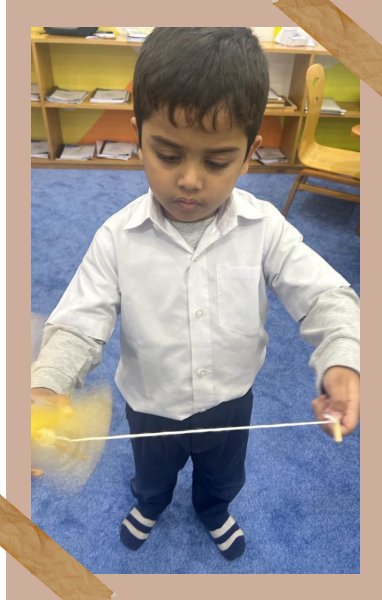

2 Recycle

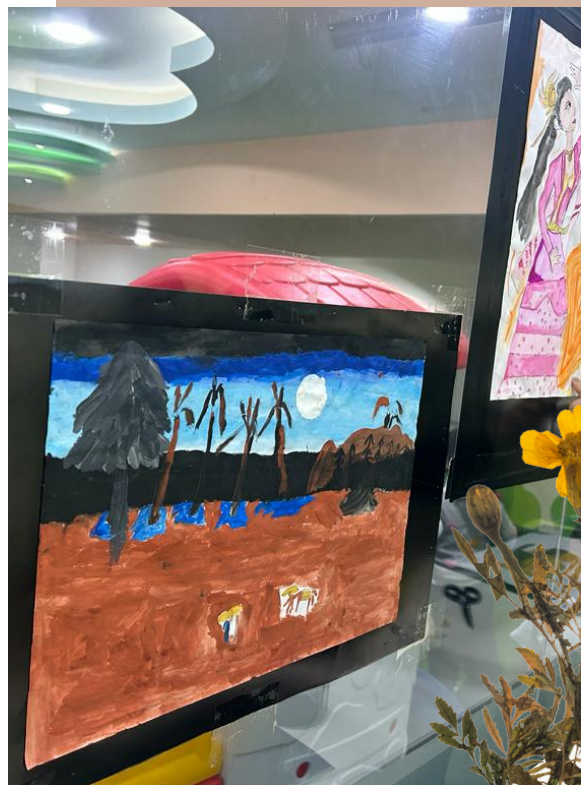
